RE: School Closure – Student Nutrition, Distance Learning and Coronavirus FAQs

DeSoto ISD Staff and Families:

We know that news of DeSoto ISD's school closures may pose real challenges for some of our families, but we appreciate everyone's understanding as we work to prioritize the safety and well-being of our students and staff.

DeSoto ISD is working diligently to continue the learning process and provide daily meals to our students. Please review the information below for details.

STUDENT NUTRITION

Starting Monday, March 16, 2020, free meals will be available to all children ages 18 years and younger at the following distribution sites:

- The Meadows Elementary
- Frank D. Moates Elementary
- DeSoto High School - Freshman Side
- Food Truck at Woodridge Elementary 9 AM - 10:45 AM
- Food Truck at Amber Terrace 11 AM - 1 PM

The packaged meals will be distributed from 9 AM to 1 PM on Monday through Friday in a drive-thru fashion. No one will need to exit their personal vehicles, but all participating children must be in the vehicle. Children do not have to be a student at the campus to qualify for the meal, and families can visit any of the participating sites.

DISTANCE LEARNING

The DeSoto ISD Teaching, Learning and Leadership Division is working with the Technology Department as well as with principals and teachers to finalize plans to provide at-home learning to the best of our abilities during the district's closure.

This week, staff and families will begin to receive correspondence from the district about lessons and other resources that will keep the educational experience in motion for our students while at home.
