**The City of Glenn Heights Police Chief Selected to Participate in a Roundtable Conversation with
President Donald Trump
Select group has been invited to discuss the future of race relations and policing**

[Glenn Heights, TX](#) -- On Thursday, June 11, 2020, the City of Glenn Heights Police Chief, V. Dooley, will participate in an invitation-only conversation with President Donald Trump and local faith leaders, law enforcement officials and small business owners. According to White House spokesman Judd Deere, the small group will “discuss solutions to historic economic, health, and justice disparities in American communities.”

The City views this opportunity as a chance to have a seat at the table to represent policing from a small city perspective, to serve as an example of policing done right and to eliminate politicizing the discussion of police reform and equitable justice. “It is a privilege to represent the City of Glenn Heights to share ideas with the President that will impact communities of similar sizes and demographics as our city,” states Chief Dooley. “Our department has implemented several changes that can serve as a model for law enforcement operations across the county.”

City Manager David Hall expands on this idea by sharing, “As administrators, a significant component of our responsibilities and duties is to engage policy makers on every level in discussions that impact our ability to serve our constituents.” Today’s conversation will be hosted at Gateway Church Dallas campus, which is 30 miles north of Glenn Heights, TX.

About the City of Glenn Heights – Incorporated in 1969, Glenn Heights is perfectly positioned along IH-35 East. Glenn Heights is a hospitable, business friendly, rapidly growing community divided between Dallas and Ellis counties. The City has a total area of 7.2 sq. miles (18.8 km sq.). More than 50% of the city’s developable land is located along major arterial intersections that are available for retail and office development.
